



HOW TO READ YOUR NET METER

Understanding Import/Export for Billing

What is Net Metering?

A Net Meter is a bidirectional meter that records both electricity taken from the grid (Import) and electricity given to the grid (Export).

Key Parameters to Check

Parameter Code	Description
kWh (Import)	Total units consumed from the Electricity Department.
kWh (Export)	Total solar units sent back to the grid.
Net kWh	Difference (Import - Export). If negative, you have surplus credit.
Instantaneous Load (kW)	Current power consumption of your house.

Billing Calculation

Billable Units = (Import Units) - (Export Units)

- If Export > Import: No electricity charge (only fixed charges). Surplus carries forward.
- If Import > Export: You pay only for the net difference.
